

SECTIONS 1A & 1B (429-202 & 429-203) PROJECT OVERVIEW

Section Overview: The Expressway Authority's first two sections of the Wekiva Parkway (State Road 429) will be located from just north of US 441 near Plymouth Sorrento Road (County Road 437) to north of Kelly Park Road. This stretch includes a local access interchange at Kelly Park Road.

Total Project Length: 4.6 miles

Estimated Construction Cost: \$121.7 million

Project Descriptions:

Section 1A (429-202): This limited access roadway from south of the Connector Road (between US 441 and Plymouth Sorrento Road) to just south of Ponkan Road will include a northbound on-ramp and a southbound off-ramp at the Connector Road, as well as bridges at the Connector Road, Southfork Drive, Yothers Road, Ponkan Road and other locations. The parkway will be depressed under planned bridges at Belgian Road and Yothers Road.

Section 1B (429-203): This project section, which begins just north of Ponkan Road, will include a new interchange at Kelly Park Road to provide access to and from SR 429. Minor work will also take place on adjacent portions of Plymouth Sorrento Road and Kelly Park Road.

Special Features: The Wekiva Parkway will include all electronic tolling for the greatest customer convenience and to maximize traffic flow. The parkway also will have aesthetics features including colored and textured treatments on some bridges and walls, as well as wider medians to accommodate enhanced landscaping.
