



SECTION 8 (FPID No. 240200-4) PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Description: This design-build project involves an interchange connecting to Interstate 4 (I-4) and State Road (S.R.) 417, completing the beltway around Central Florida. The project includes building the general use lanes for the future Interstate 4 (I-4) Beyond the Ultimate project; the express lanes for that project will be built by others.

Work will include bridges, drainage, safety lighting under bridges and at the interchange, utilities and other roadway features.

Project Limits: Parkway: From Orange Boulevard, to east of Rinehart Road; I-4: From south of S.R. 417 to south of S.R. 46

Project Length: 2.63 miles

Project Status: Design-Build

Special Features: A parkway gateway feature will be built west of International Parkway. The parkway will include aesthetic walls and other features. A toll gantry will be built on this section. The Wekiiva Parkway includes all electronic tolling for the greatest customer convenience and to keep traffic moving.

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
